Alea III to begin fourth season

Alea III, Boston University's contemporary music ensemble under the direction of Theodore Antoniou, will present the first concert of its fourth season, Oct. 24. The program, to commence at 8 p.m. at the Longy School of Music, 1 Follen Street, Cambridge, will include works by composers from three generations of the 20th century.

The program will include Darius Milhaud, "Symphonies for Small Orchestra"; Frederic Rzewski, "Four Pieces for Piano"; Steve Reich, "Octet" and Gyorgy Ligeti, "Chamber Concerto for 13 instrumentalists."
